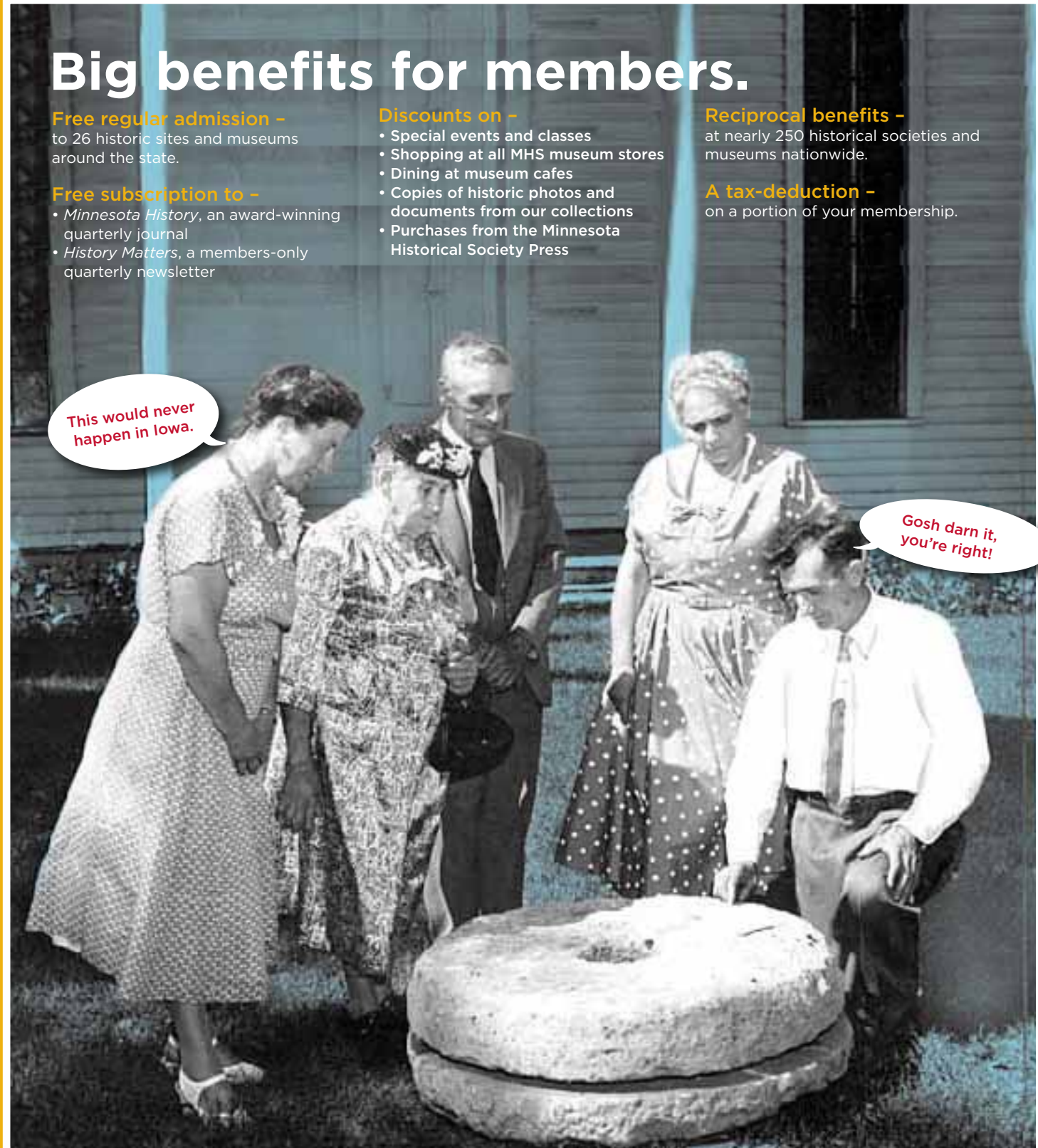

About the Minnesota Historical Society.

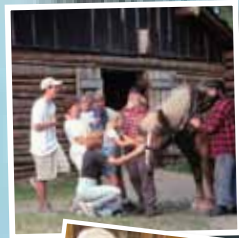

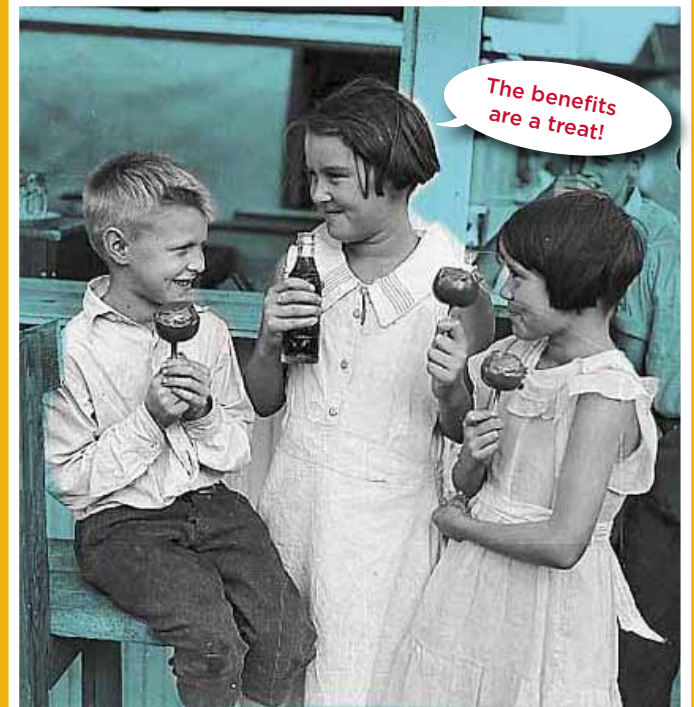
